2. ABOUT PROSPERO

The selected candidate will be tasked with overseeing program leadership, direction, and management. They will also be responsible for leading reporting and interactions with USAID, as well as nurturing existing relationships with government ministries and agencies, other donor programs, and pertinent associations. The program is expected to commence in 2024, and the position will be located in Zambia.

Zambia Diversification Support Intervention (ZADS)Program overview:

USAID/Zambia will be implementing the ZADS Interventions program, intending to transform Zambia's agricultural sector into a proficient, equitable, and sustainable supplier of high-quality and nutritious food for both consumption and trade. Targeting the Copperbelt, Central, and Eastern Provinces for implementation, this initiative aims to spur growth in Zambia's agricultural sector and strengthening its ability to withstand climate related challenges. Additionally, it seeks to boost the market competitiveness of certain commodities while expanding the range of

nutritious options available, potentially improving dietary consumption at rural households.

Responsibilities:

- Provide strategic guidance, leadership, management, and general technical oversight for the program. Continuously seek to enhance operational efficiencies and introduce innovations in delivery methods.
- Supervise the development and timely submission of project deliverables within the allocated budget.
